- Features classic games re-invented in HD, new multi-touch Battle Arena games for simultaneous head-to-head play, and future games and content that auto-download each month.
- Includes superior management capabilities, giving operators more control of games, menus, and pricing options both on and off location.
- Boasts a 22" screen with multi-touch technology, allowing multiple users to play games together, plus it's designed to auto-calibrate, eliminating the process of manual calibration.
- Powered by Microsoft Windows® Embedded Standard 7, including the latest in wired and wireless Windows networking security and support.
- Stores all machine settings "in the cloud" and re-downloads them after factory restores, hard drive swaps, etc.
- Most components can be instantly accessed and removed without tools. All hardware components can be swapped without losing machine serial number.
- Features innovative airflow mechanics that channel cool air onto the hard drive, motherboard, and into the LCD assembly, while pushing warm air generated by the power supply directly out of the unit.
- Cabinet illuminates bar top with 360 degrees of ambient lighting.
- Both the ML-1 and Megatouch Live require broadband connectivity.

In-game Challenges:

All ML-1 games are enhanced with a series of in-game challenges that reward players for feats of skill. While some are simple, others require multiple plays or mastery of the game. Challenges are the primary way for players to earn points that contribute to their Megatouch Live Score.



Megatouch Live Score:

A player's Megatouch Live Score is a cumulative tally of points earned from games played and defeated in-game challenges. Players are ranked based on their Megatouch Live Score, giving due recognition to the most elite players across our entire portfolio of games.



Tokens & Upgrades:

Tokens are a new form of virtual currency that can be used to buy virtual goods, but not to play games. At the beginning of each game, Megatouch Live players can use tokens to purchase one of three exclusive upgrades that gives them a competitive edge over other players. Upgrades can prove essential to completing certain challenges or achieving higher scores.



Global Leaderboards:

Megatouch Live players don't just compete against each other on the same machine, they're competing against every Megatouch Live player around the world. Game leaderboards now display rankings four different ways: per machine, worldwide for that specific month, worldwide for the previous month, and all-time worldwide. Players can even post their scores and accomplishments to Facebook.



Player Accounts:

Megatouch Live is free to join—all a player needs is an e-mail address. Accounts are created right on screen in just a few easy steps. Players create their own username and can select either an existing avatar or their own photo from Facebook to represent them on screen. All data is stored in the cloud, so no matter what machine a player uses, they'll never see repeat content and they'll always have access to their accomplishments, high scores, and purchased tokens. Signing in requires a username and password, or can simply be done by swiping a credit card or a Megatouch Live Player Card.
